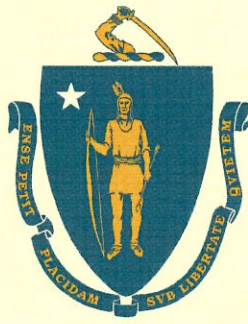


The Commonwealth of Massachusetts



A Proclamation

Whereas, The Association of Government Accountants (AGA) was founded in 1950 by a group of federal accountants and expanded in 1975 to include state and local government finance professionals; and

Whereas, The Boston Chapter of the Association of Government Accountants is one of ninety chapters across the country and serves the needs of federal and state government, and private organizations in New England. This chapter is a professional organization with 291 active members representing federal, state, municipal and private sector accountants, auditors and financial managers in Massachusetts; and

Whereas, Awarded by the Association of Government Accountants, the Certified Government Financial Managers certification program encourages the critical need for an increased emphasis on the professional qualifications and stature of government financial managers; and

Whereas, The certified Government Financial Manager program provides a means of demonstrating professionalism and competency by requiring candidates to have appropriate educational and employment history, to abide by AGA's Code of Ethics and to pass a three part examination requiring expertise in various financial subjects; and

Whereas, Certified Government Financial managers respond to AGA's mission of Advancing Government Accountability, as it continues its educational efforts with emphasis on high standards of conduct, honor, and character in its Code of Ethics, and are making significant advances both in professional ability and in service to the residents of Massachusetts,

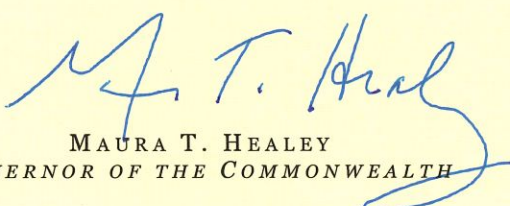
Now, Therefore, I, Maura T. Healey, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim March 2025, to be,

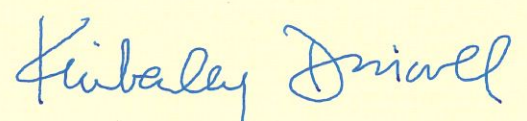

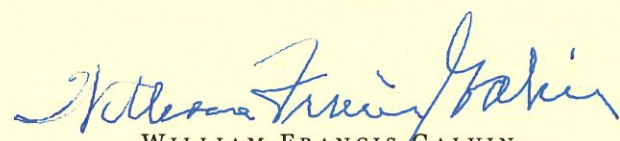
And urge all residents of the Commonwealth to take cognizance of this event and participate fittingly in its observance.
