The Public Schools system purchased a large-scale solar panel farm that will save \$1.8 million in electricity costs over the next 20 years. The product contains nearly 4,000 solar panels that will produce almost 2,000 megawatt hours of energy annually.



Beverly Triton Nature Park Shoreline Protection Project is continuing successfully to reduce erosion rates, protect existing natural water habitats and protect the recreational park and walking paths and for the public.

Anne Arundel County Public Schools continue to be higher than the state average in terms of the number of students who graduate in four years.


Revenues & Expenses







Specified Items

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Increase: Transportation reliability by creating a multi-model transportation system that provides practical and reliable transportation choices and connections for all users.



Decrease: School environment issues by increasing funding for the renovation, expansion, and resplendent for school facilities. \$738 million allocated for the six-year capital program for the Board of Education Projects.



Decrease: Police Department is partnering up with schools and rehabilitation centers to decrease the use and fatal deaths of opium and other harmful drugs and additives.

Increase: Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works Bureau of Waste Management Services has invested into its recycling prunes morning for residents. This leads to lower disposal costs, more preservation of landfill capacity, and lower charges for the services provided.



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
