CEC Meeting Minutes April 28, 2021

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 12:03 pm by Nathan Ziegler

II. Name of Attendees and Absentees

III. Membership update

- a. We have had 62 member renewals, 34 that have not renewed, and 1 new member
 - i. 16 of those that renewed are CGFM
 - ii. 2 of those that have not renewed are CGFM
- b. We had 86 members last year
- c. We've retained 72% of members, our goal was 85%
 - i. Monica will reach out to those who have not renewed
 - ii. Some members may not have logins and may have trouble renewing strictly through the website. We can provide links to those members to assist

IV. Survey results

- a. Members would like to see both virtual and in person CPE opportunities
 - i. We can potentially split our meetings evenly, with half in person and half virtual
 - 1. We will need to work with 425 on how flexible we can be with our schedule
 - ii. Sound quality was an issue with the combined in person and virtual event
 - 1. We could potentially have just a powerpoint show for those attending virtually, with live sound
 - 2. Picking up our own quality mic may help with sound issues
 - iii. Conferences IO allows CPE participation for both those in person and virtual
 - 1. Requires an annual subscription
 - iv. We currently Share GoToWebinar with Dallas and Oklahoma. Should we purchase our own subscription?
 - 1. Our registration fees are split 3 ways
 - a. We charged \$60 for CPE, but lowered our rate as Dallas and Oklahoma were charging \$40
 - b. Based on how many members attended, we brought in \$440 more than we received after the split
 - c. We received 100% of our membership fees charged

- 2. An annual subscription costs \$1,200
 - a. Our agreement expires in September, before the fall seminar
- 3. Having our own subscription would allow us to collect revenue from outside our chapter and advertise our CPE opportunities to non-members on the national site.
- 4. May make it clearer to members how to sign up since all links would come from the Ozarks chapter
- b. Keynote speakers at fall and spring seminars
 - i. We can reach out to national for recommendations
 - ii. Keynote speakers may be easier to reach if we are doing a virtual seminar
- c. The partnership with Dallas and Oklahoma was well received
 - i. We may reach out to the St Louis chapter as well
- d. Creating interest in CEC
 - i. Have an overview of each position in the newsletter
 - ii. Create a LinkedIn page for the chapter
- e. More variety in ethics CPE
 - i. What areas can we explore beyond fraud?
 - 1. Conflicts of interest
- f. Spend less time on polling questions. Moving on faster may help with pacing

V. Scholarship update

- a. We have two \$500 scholarships available
- b. The due date is April 30th and we have not received any applications at this time

VI. ACE update

- a. The ACE program runs from June to May
- b. We're currently in gold and 375 points from platinum
 - i. Membership numbers can potentially earn us another 400 points
 - ii. We can add more CPE hours
 - 1. Kristy currently has a webinar speaker for May
 - iii. We can also add another stand-alone community service event
 - 1. This does not have to be with a 501c3 organization, just a general community service project

VII. Officers and Chairs for 2021-2022

- a. Greg will collect information regarding next year's CEC positions
 - i. Greg will be leaving the CEC this year, after 8 years of volunteering
