We, the undersigned, all citizens of the United States, and a majority citizens and residents of the District of Columbia, desiring to associate ourselves as a corporation pursuant to the provisions of Title 29 of Chapter 6 of the District of Columbia Code (1940), do hereby certify as follows:

First. The name or title by which this corporation shall be known in law shall be

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTANTS ASSOCIATION

Second. The term for which it is organized shall be perpetual

Third. The particular business and objects of said corporation shall be

To unite the professional accountants in the Federal Service for constructive endeavors.

To encourage and provide a means for free interchange of ideas among accountants in the Federal Service.

To aid in the improvement of accounting and auditing in the Federal Government, and

To contribute to the improvement of education in the field of accountancy, with emphasis on the application of accounting and auditing to the activities of the Federal Government.

Fourth. The number of its trustees, directors, or managers for the first year of its existence shall be nine
